COURSE TITLE: A.P. Physics C

TEXT: University Physics: by Young & Freedman

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Physics C is focused on the study of mechanics and electromagnetism.

COURSE ASSESSMENT:

1. Daily work and lab assignments will count 40% toward the total class grade.
