Click Menu, then the **Library Media Center** Tab, scroll down, click "**Library Catalog and Databases**" on the left side of page.

1. Before you begin researching you will create a Works Cited page in Google Docs.
 - a. Log into your EPS Gmail Account username@edmondschools.net (same password as computer)
 - b. Click Rubiks Cube (or Matrix) to access Google Apps, click Drive
 - c. Click "New" then down to New Google Doc
 - d. Change the title from "Untitled Document" to "Health Works Cited" click "Enter"
 - e. Center your cursor, Type "Works Cited" hit enter twice, then align the cursor to the left.
 - f. Paste citations as you find them.
 - g. After finding all of your citations, Ctrl +A, format double space, Change Font to Times New Roman, Size 12
 - h. Create a Hanging Indent by adjusting the tabs on the top Ruler.

 2. On the right side, at the top of the Pro. Vs. Con. Box, click the link which says **View All Issues**
 3. Read through the choices till you find your topic, click the link.
 4. On this page are links to articles both for and against the topics.
- B. **Issues and Controversies** – explores hundreds of hot topics in politics, government, business, society, education, and popular culture. For the citation click "Page Tools"

- C. **EBSCOhost** — contains periodical, newspaper, and the most recent articles on topics

 1. Click **High School Research**
 2. Enter your key words and search.
- D. **Another helpful EBSCO location:**
 - a. Go back to EBSCO's home page.
 - b. Click on **EBSCOhost Web**
 - c. Click the box saying Select All, then Continue.
 - d. **VERY IMPORTANT** - In the middle of the page, under Limit Your Results, click the **Full Text** box.
 - e. Enter your key words and search.
- E. **Metro Library - Opposing Viewpoints in Context** – contains articles, reference materials, audio clips, etc. presenting both sides of your topic. This is also a good place to get basic facts to help you support or oppose the argument.
