1. Before you begin researching you will create a Works Cited page in Google Docs.

- a. Log into Google Chrome, open Drive, Click New, then Doc
- b. Change the title from “Untitled Document” to “Holocaust Works Cited” Click Enter.
- c. At the top of your screen click the Line and Paragraph spacing icon (four lines with up/down arrows), scroll down to “Double” click it.
- d. Center your cursor, type “Works Cited”, then left justify.
- e. For every source you find, you will copy/paste the source citation into this Google Doc. When you have completed your paper, you will delete the sources you didn’t use.
- f. Alphabetize your list – Click “Add-Ons” Menu, search for “Sorted Paragraphs” click “Free” then “Allow” Highlight your citations, go to add-ons menu, sorted paragraphs, sort from A-Z (note if an entry starts with quotations, the computer will place it at the beginning of the list, you will need to copy/paste that entry into its proper location)
