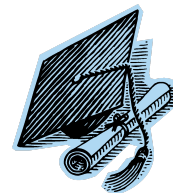

Dress Code

All graduates must come with their caps and gowns. Hang it up in a dark place until graduation day. If you have not received one yet, please call Jostens at the number below. There will NOT be any caps/gowns on site for use. The number for Jostens is 607-4343. Graduates without their caps and gowns will not be able to participate. **PUT YOUR NAME IN YOUR CAP FOR WHEN YOU TOSS THEM UP.**

We ask you to dress appropriately for the occasion. Males must be in slacks, with collared shirt, ties are optional and nice, clean shoes (NO athletic shoes). Females must be in a dress or skirt that does not fall below the gown or nice pants. Flats or low heels are best because the graduates will be walking a lot. Graduates are not allowed to carry purses or have jewelry on the outside of his/her gown. **NO Stiletto-type heels**, they will become caught on the turf and you will trip.

Seniors are NOT to decorate their caps for any reason.

Graduation Practice

May 21, graduation practice will begin at 9:20 a.m. in the main gym. We will practice the line-up, walking in, receiving the diploma and going over last minute instructions. *This is mandatory if you want to participate in graduation.* DO NOT BE LATE. Do not bring your gown.

Graduation

Be there no later than **6:20**, dressed and ready to go. We march at 6:50. **Tickets are not necessary.** Graduation is scheduled to be over no later than 9:30 p.m.

-After the ceremony, no parents will be allowed on the field, so it is a good idea to have a predetermined meeting place. Graduates will exit on the visitor's south side gate.

-Make up in case of inclement weather is Saturday, May 22nd at 7 p.m. at Edmond Memorial Stadium.

-This year tickets will not be required in order to attend graduation. We are requesting that attendance only include immediate families, not extended families. Masks are required at Graduation for all attendees (graduates, employees, and guests).
